

Site Specific Policies: COVID-19

EFFECTIVE: 5/4/2020

Project Rules:

- Follow CDC guidelines for COVID-19.
- If you do not feel safe working, you do not have to work. Contact your supervisor if you have any concerns.
- Zero tolerance. Report any misconduct to the adherence of these rules.
- Every person coming on site must complete and submit a self-screening check. See screening signs with QR codes posted on site for directions.
- Trade supervisors must assure that each one of their employees have completed a self-screening each day before starting work.
- Limit the sharing of personal hand tools. Disinfect common handles on tools and equipment in use.
- Wash your hands often. Wash before work, after removing gloves, before and after use of shared items, before and after meal or restroom break and after work.
- Keep a 6 ft. distance from others while working. If duties, or safety of activity, requires closer interaction, a written plan for that activity must be submitted, as additional measures might be needed. Masks will be mandatory for these activities.
- Keep a 6 ft. distance from others while on break.
- Cleanup and disposal of food and beverage items are required daily.
- No general entry to job trailers / site office.
- Stay home if you are symptomatic and report symptoms to your supervisor. Do not return until cleared. Reference CDC guidelines.
- Stay in the construction zone and limit unnecessary travel within the project.

Additional Recommendations / Notes:

- Carpooling is discouraged. If driving separate is not possible, wear masks while driving.
- Wear gloves, masks and other PPE as often as possible (if not a requirement above).
- Wash re-usable PPE often.
